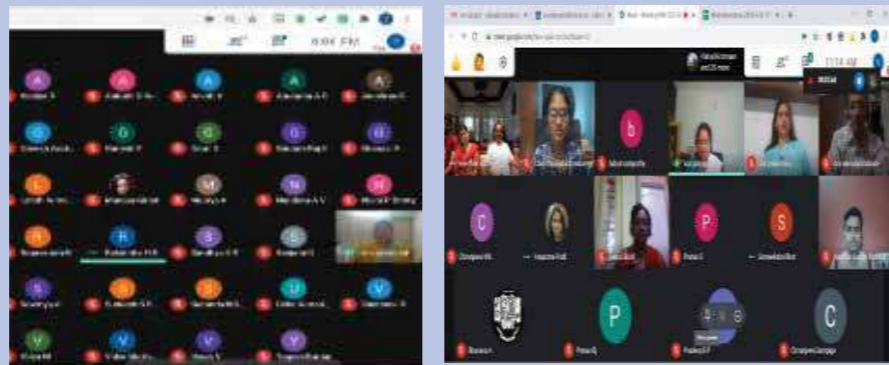

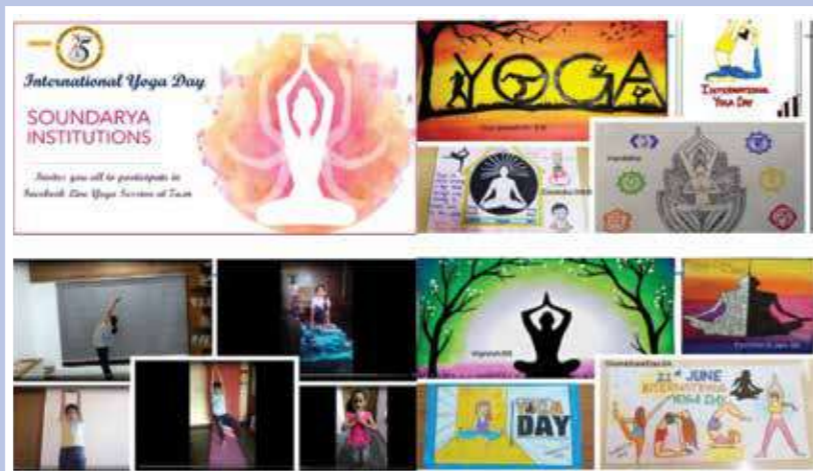
writing were planned according to the grades and all the activities were well executed in online mode.

Yoga Day

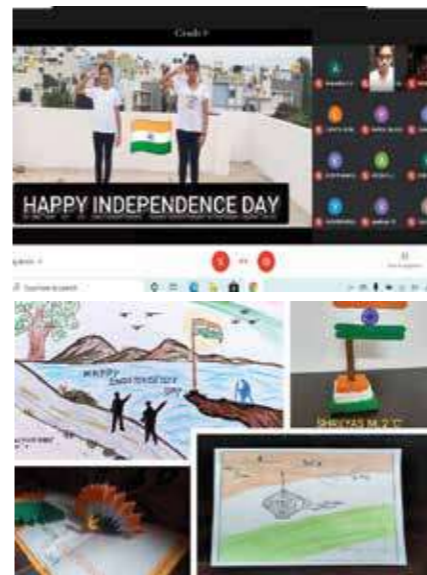

Independence Day

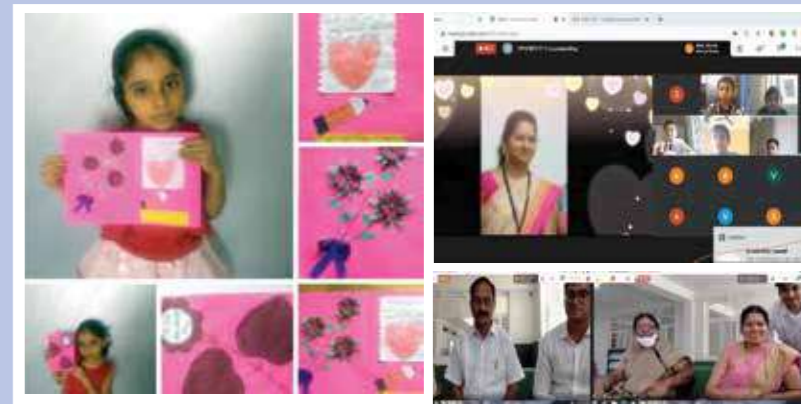
Independence – a word which every mind sings in union, for which every minute particle earnestly waits. The melodious music sung by the unsung heroes of the past.



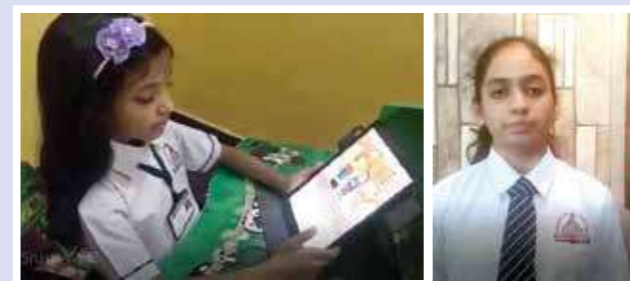

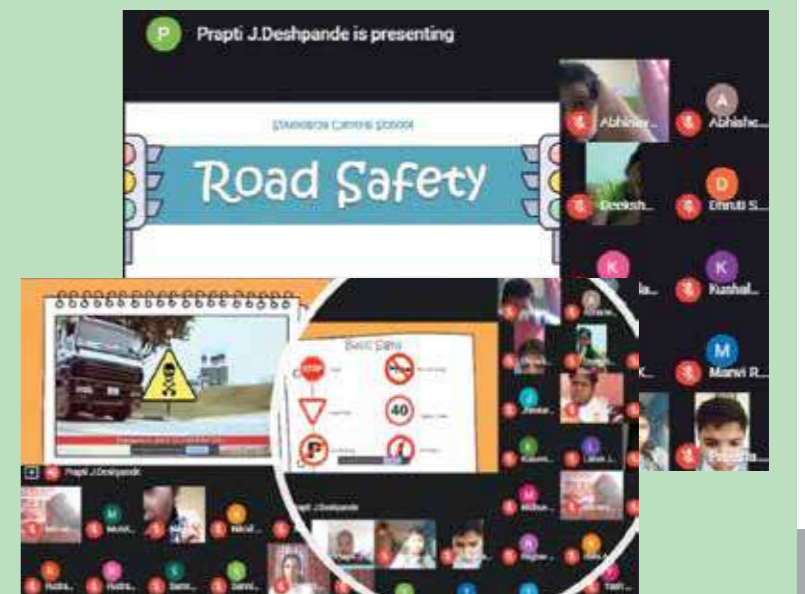

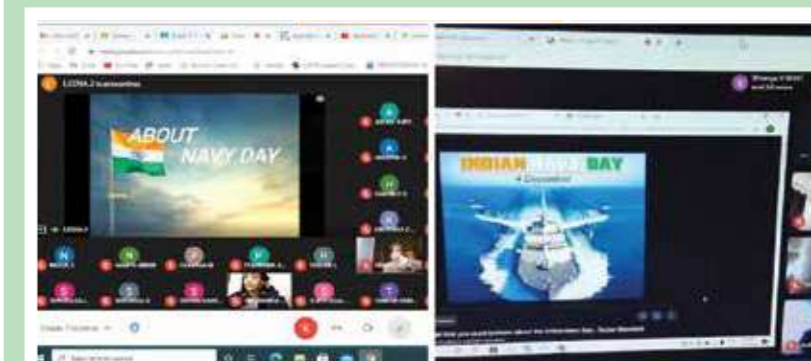
World Mountain Day

SCS keeps a close eye on the updates of a Corona virus (covid 19) and is taking the appropriate safety precautions to educate students and parents every week.

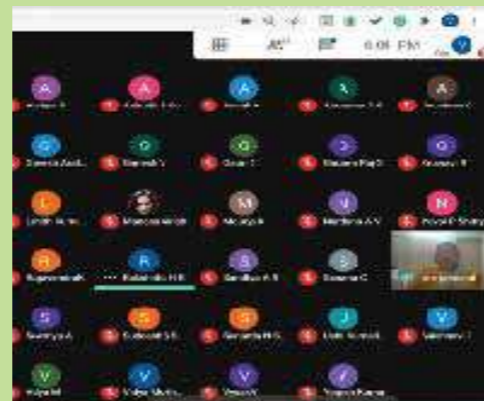

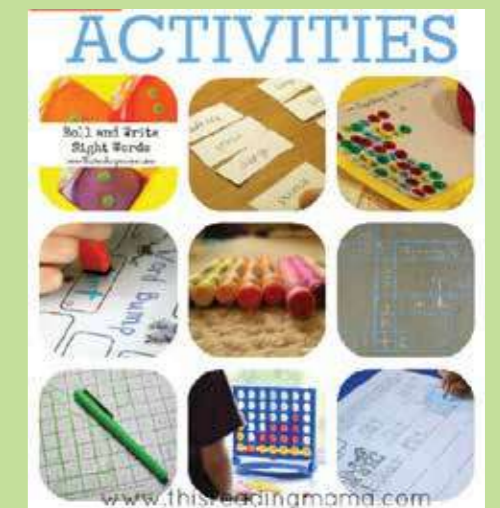

Fun Learning Assignments

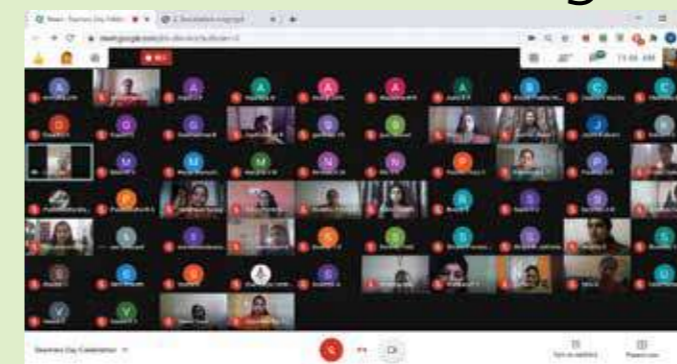

In-Service Training

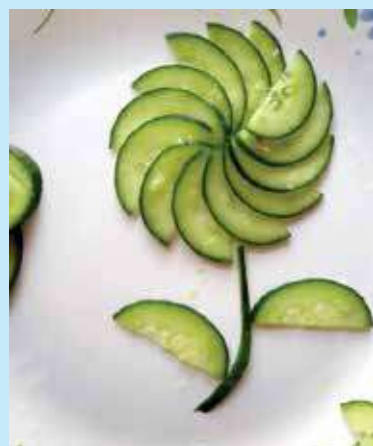
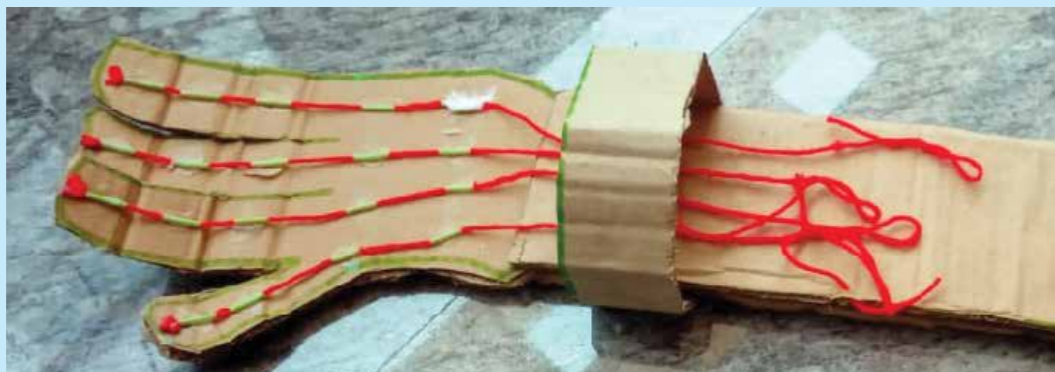

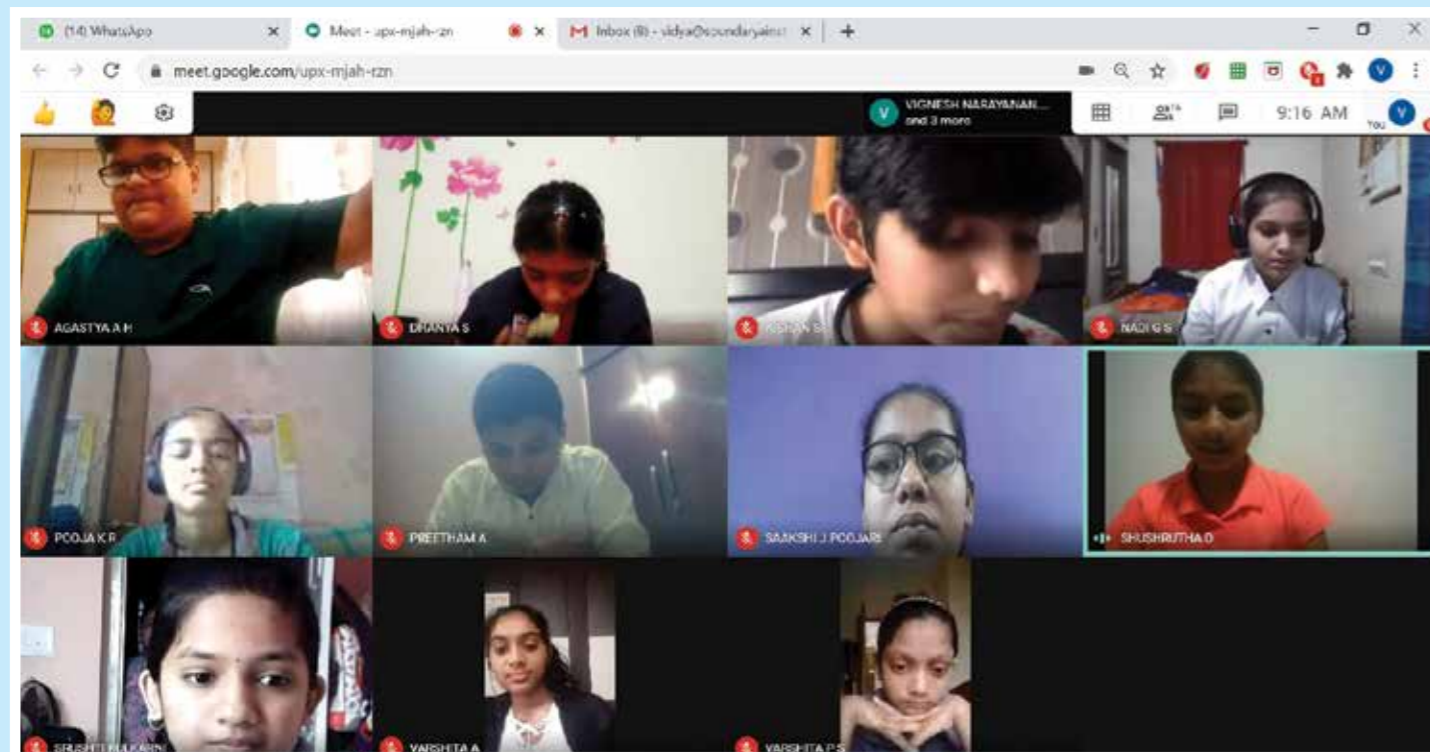

Thermometer Cricket

Temperature affects the rate of chirping in grasshoppers and crickets. The Snowy tree cricket has been called the "thermometer cricket" because it is possible to calculate the temperature in Fahrenheit by adding 40 to the number of chirps it makes in 15 seconds.

A few insects such as long-horned grasshopper have well-developed hearing organs. On both the front legs, just below the knee there are two slit-like opening through which sound enters the ear. The ears

contain air sacs which act like sound boxes. Sensory cells on the air sacs respond to vibrations in the air. In the breeding season Bullfrogs make loud sound to attract female and drive other mates away. The sounds are made by air being passed to and from the mouth the lungs across the vocal cords. Some of the air enters air sacs in the floor of the mouth which inflate like a balloon and act as a sound box to make the sound louder.

The success of campaigns like 'Catch the Rain` is important as widespread installation of these systems is also revitalizing the natural properties of land, helping to improve the quality of groundwater, raising its level, and preventing wells and tube-wells from drying up. Additionally, efficient deployment of rainwater harvesting systems is limiting surface runoff of water, is reducing the soil erosion, and increasing its fertility.

Whom we talked to... once in a year

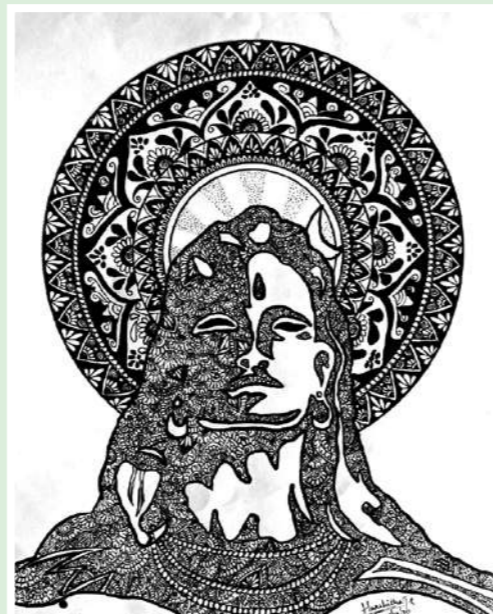
