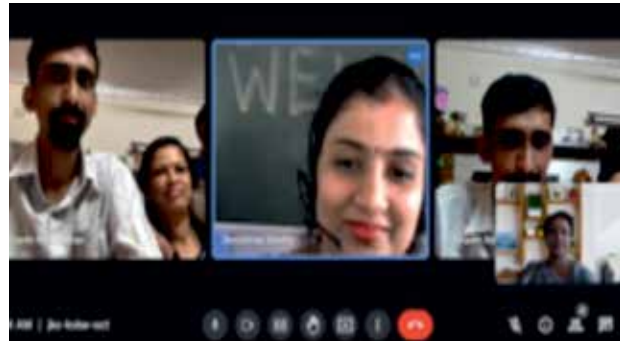

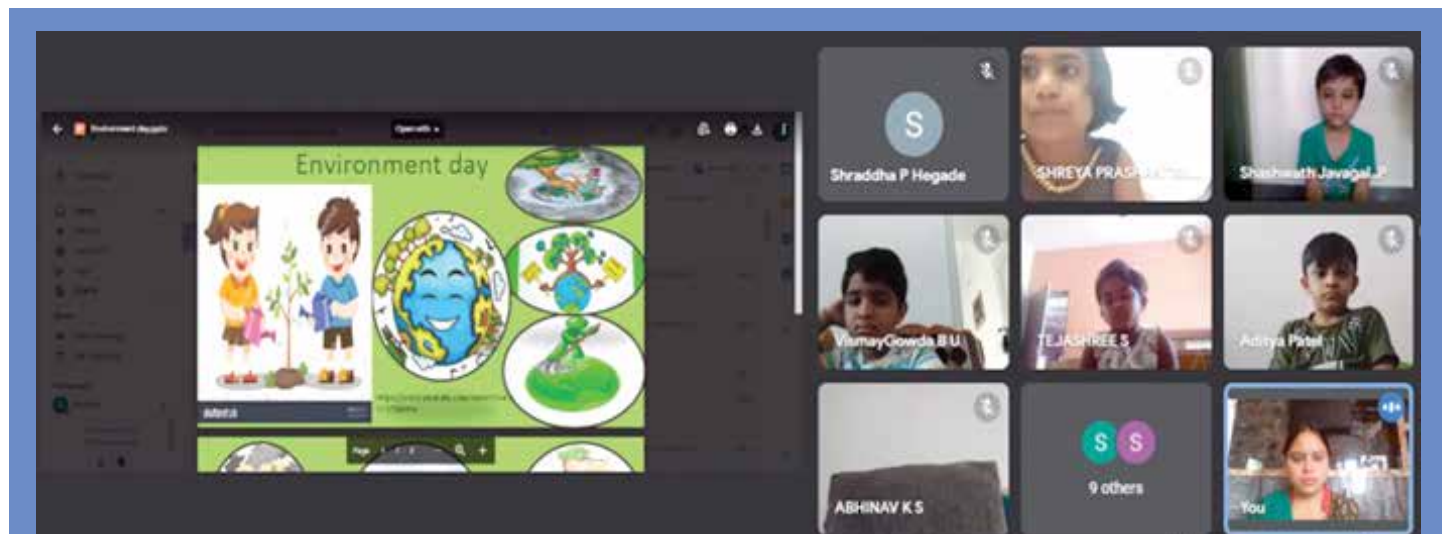


Parent Orientation

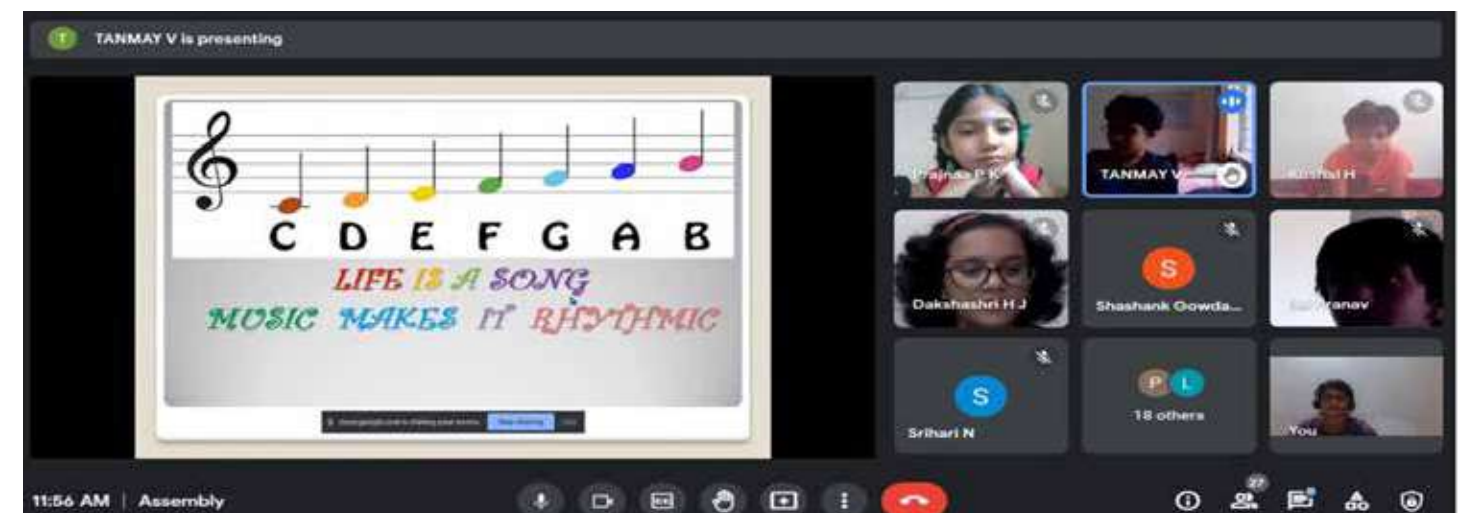
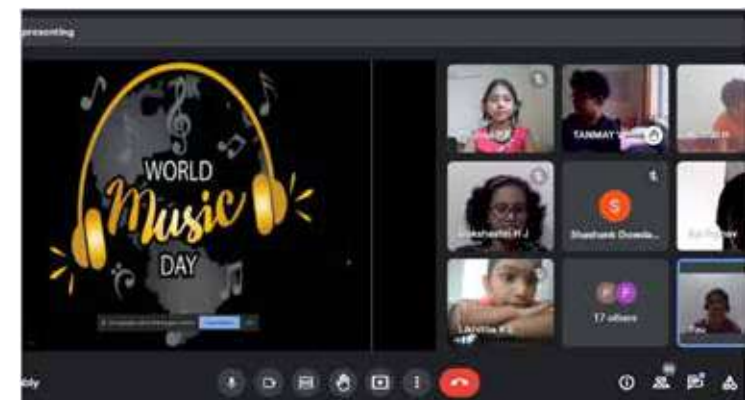


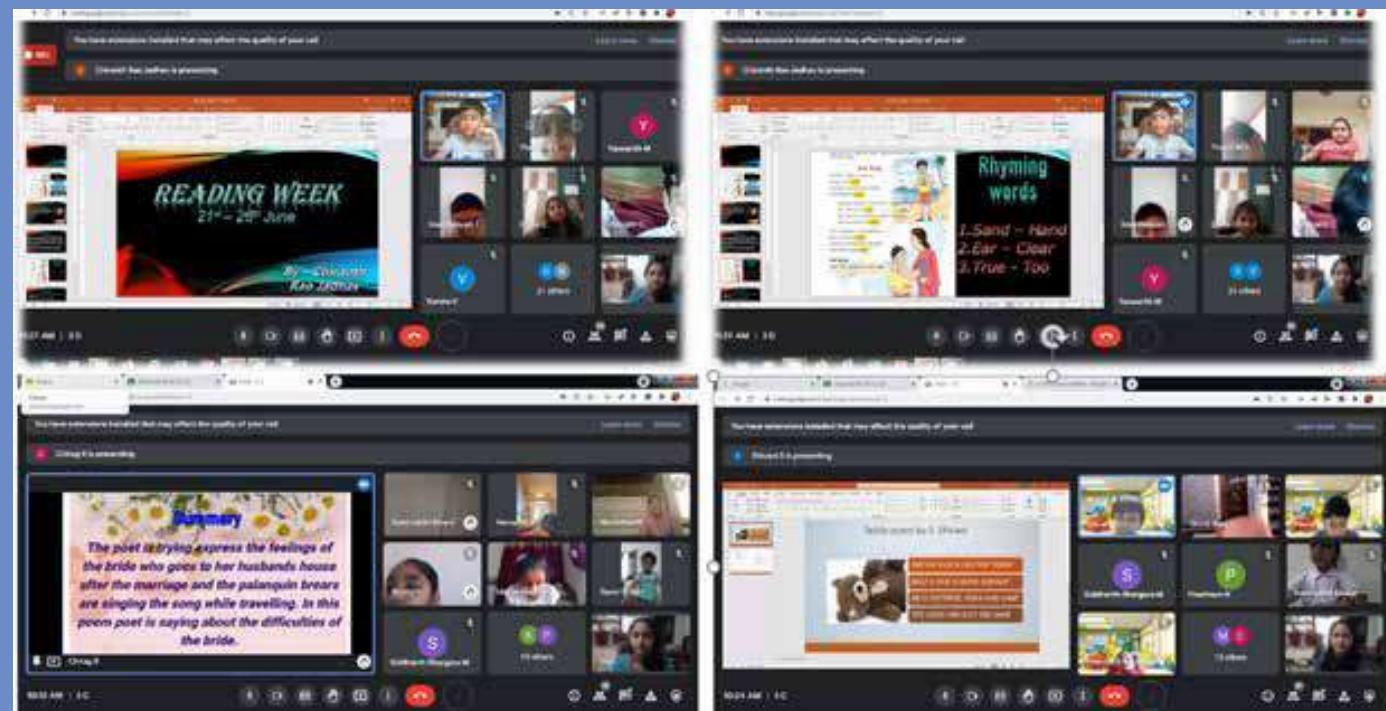
World Music Day

The event ended by students showcasing their gratitude by saluting all the healthcare professionals.

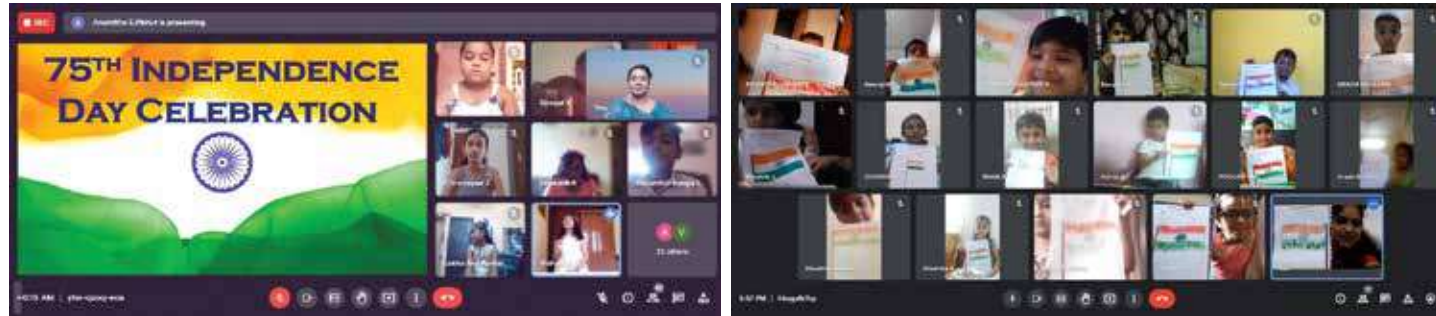


Independence Day

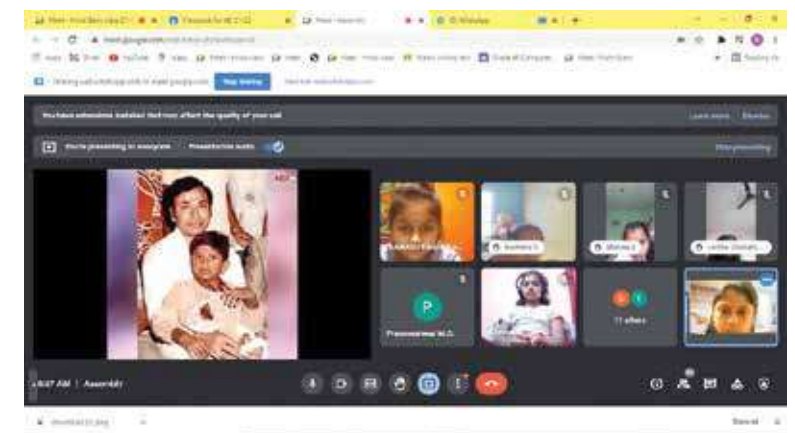

Sankranthi

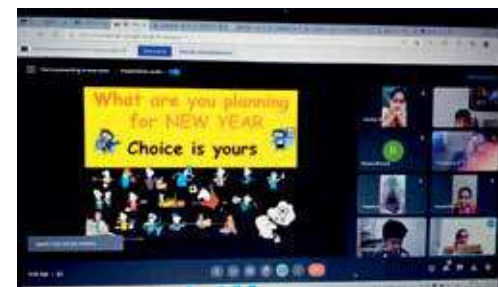

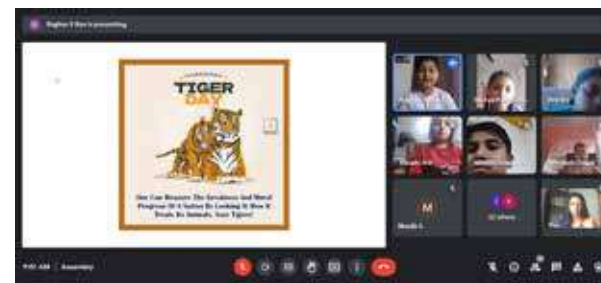


Unique Events Preparatory

Global Handwashing Day- Instilling values in the students is the duty of a teacher.

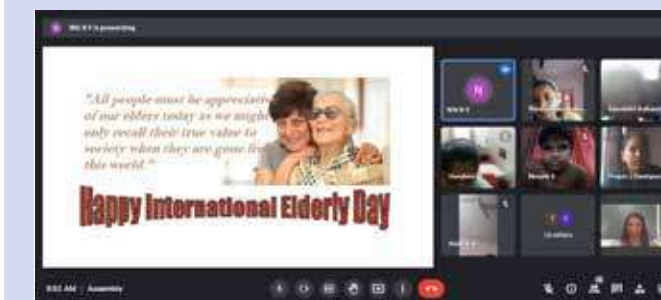

World Soil Day

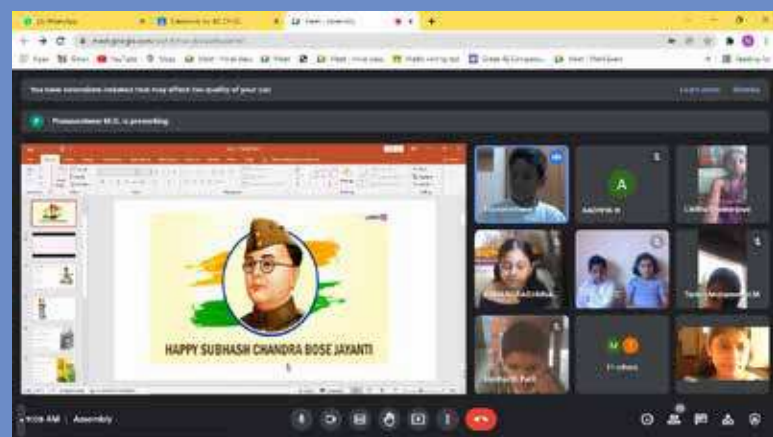
There can be no life without soil and no soil without life; They have evolved together.

National Tourism Day

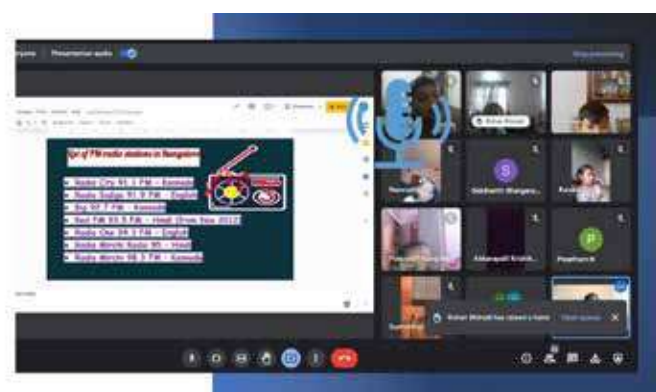

Atal Lab Inauguration

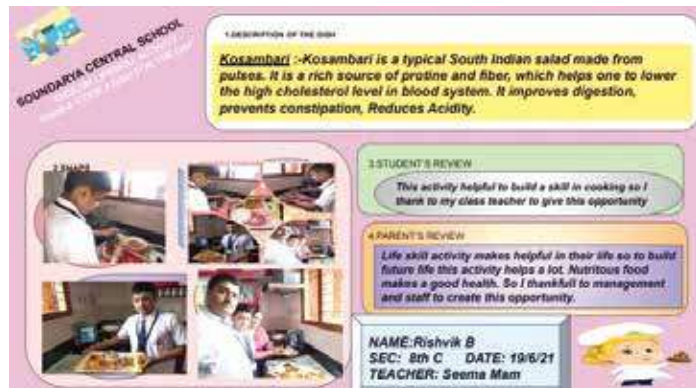
